STUNT AND PYRAMID DEDUCTIONS

An obvious CONTROLLED fall = (.1 deduction)

an obvious stunt fall where the athletes demonstrate safe control throughout the fall.

A coed / coed style stunt fall = (.1 deduction)

an obvious stunt fall during the attempt of a coed or coed style stunt.

An obvious OUT OF CONTROL fall =

(see deduction chart)

an obvious stunt fall where the athletes are out of control during the fall.

RUNNING AND STANDING TUMBLING DEDUCTION VALUE CHART

STANDING AND RUNNING TUMBLING DEDUCTION

Obvious Skill Fall = (.25 deduction)

a fall during the attempt of a tumbling skill.

(2 knees, 2 hands, seat or body have contact with the floor)
